Ag Commissioner staff will be available at trainings to take photos as well.

To complete your application and to receive your new Ag Pass card, you are required to participate in an Ag Pass training session. Trainings are approximately four (4) hours in length, and will be hosted by Sacramento County Office of Emergency Services and the Agricultural Commissioner’s Office. ***Please contact the Sacramento County Agricultural Commissioner’s Office to learn when the next training will be offered.***
